The film uses fascinating animations to bring his graphics to life. His work has appeared on the covers of many books and albums. Narrated by Stephen Fry. Directed by Robin Lutz it won the Dutch Crystal Film award for documentary films in 2018. First time shown in Australia to accompany the current exhibition of Escher's work at the NGV.
